
CONCLUSION


Fentanyl Patch Market Analysis

FENTANYL - NATIONAL SPEND / PACKS BY MONTH




FENTANYL TOP PRODUCTS BY EXPENDITURE - NATIONAL SPEND / PACKS NOVEMBER 2016




FENTANYL 12MCG PATCHES TARIFFS
