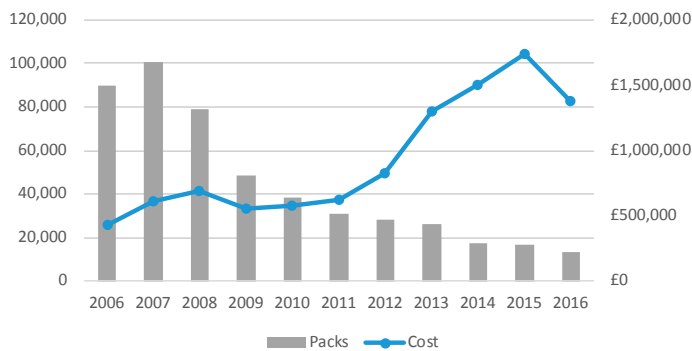

SABAs stimulate Beta2 receptors in the lung inducing relaxation of bronchial smooth muscle, bronchodilation and increased bronchial airflow. The cyclic AMP released also acts locally to prevent the release of bronchoconstrictor mediators such as histamine & leukotrienes from the airway mast cells.

Salbutamol Tablet prescribing is costing the NHS in excess of £2million per annum. This spend can be reduced by 99% by optimising across to Salbutamol Solution.

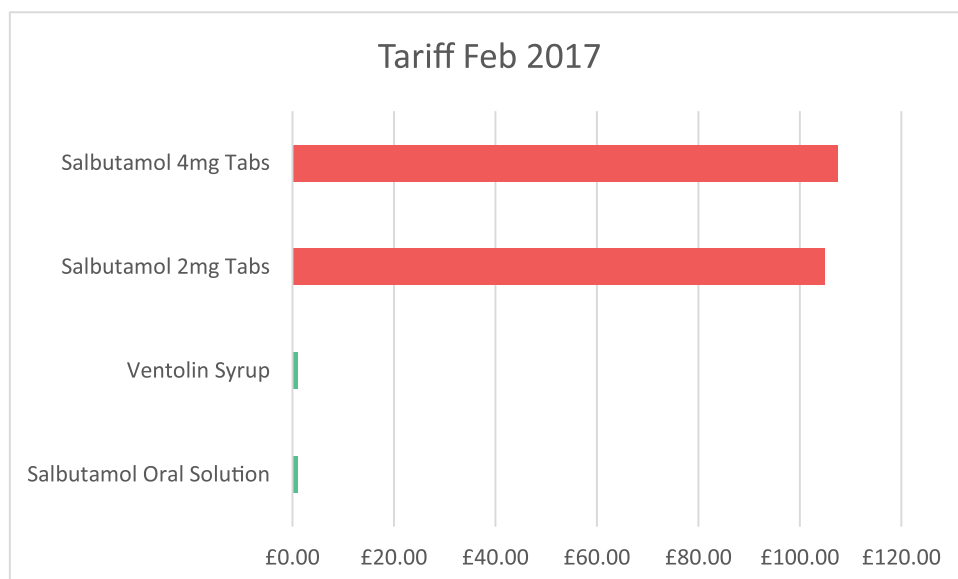

Salbutamol Tablets: The price of Salbutamol Tablets has escalated to over £100 per pack for both the 2mg and 4mg strengths. This is costing the NHS nearly £2 million per year. Ventolin Syrup (Salbutamol 2mg/5ml oral solution sugar free 150mls) costs £1.15 providing a 99% price reduction per dose and a saving of over £100 per script.

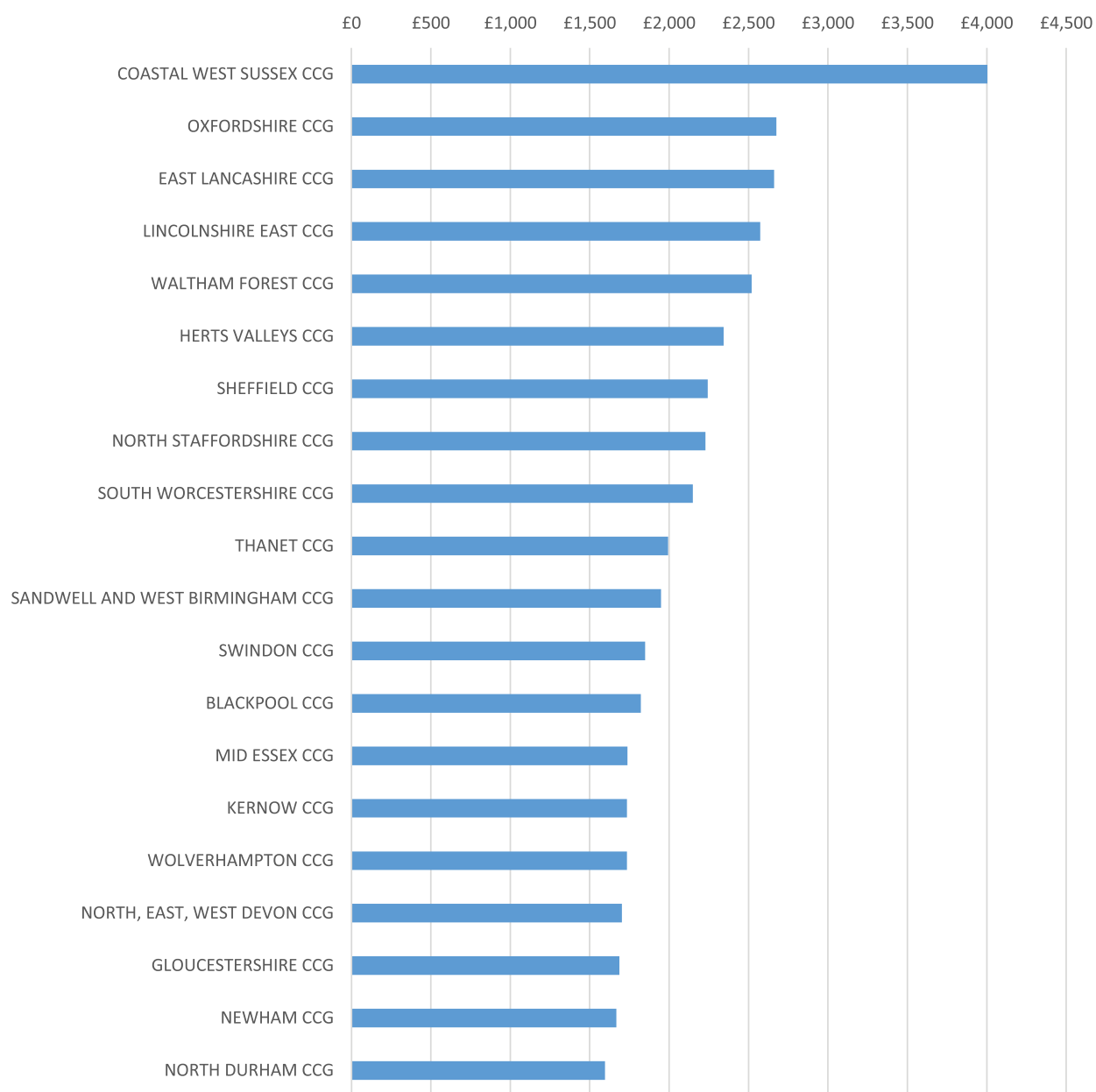
